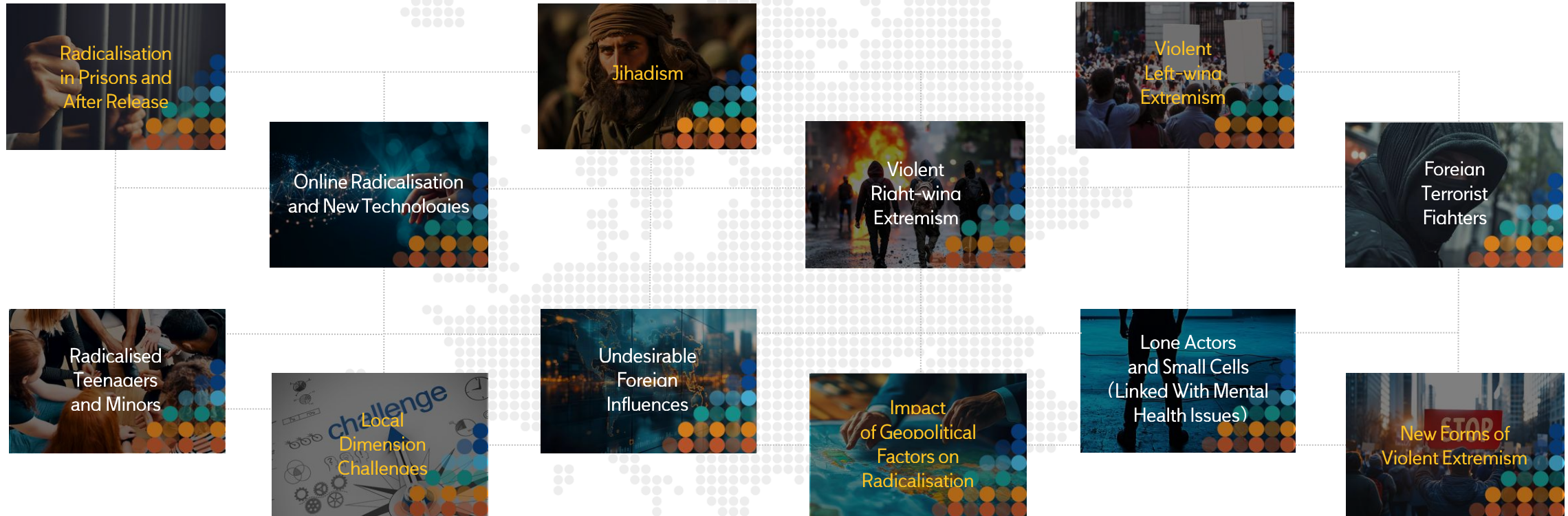

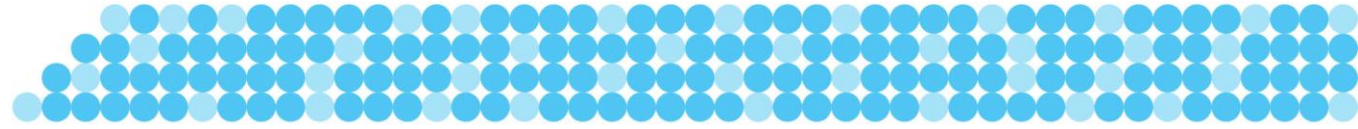

Learning from Each Other

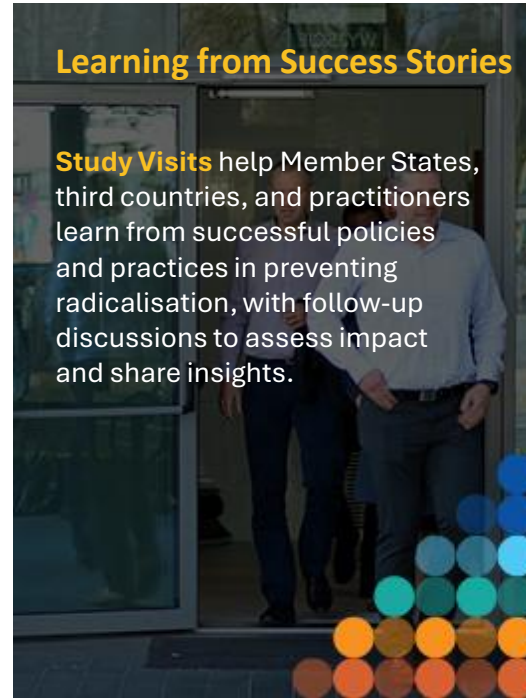
Ad-hoc Workshops and Events

Strategic Communications helps Member States develop effective communication strategies to tackle current threats, providing services like meetings, training, research and tailor-made support.

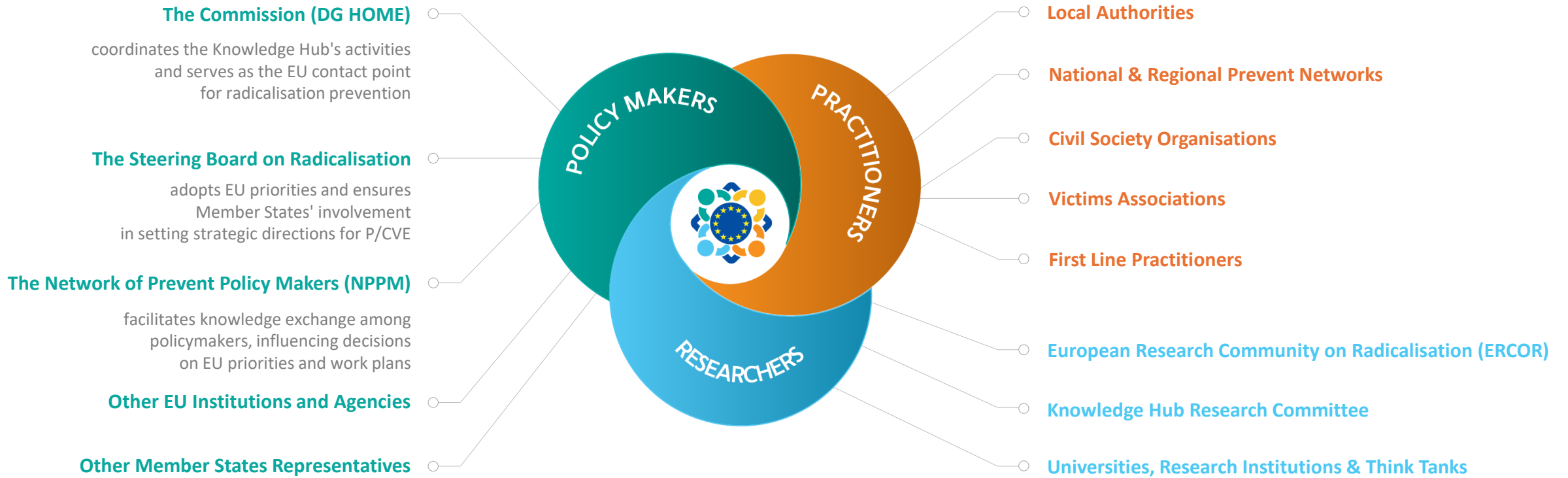
Preparing for the Future

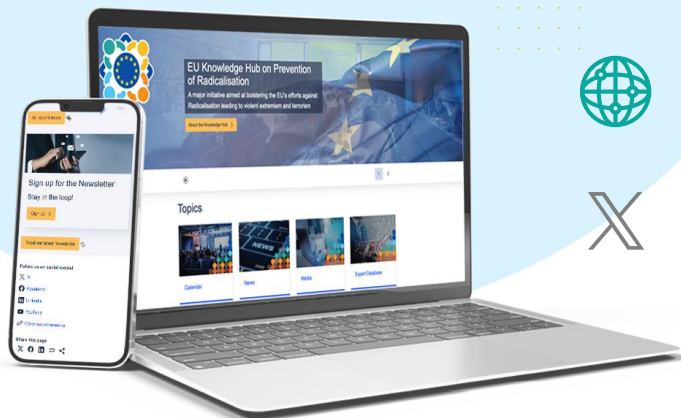
